eASPIRE

eASPIRE is the Internet-based version of ASPIRE and provides one-on-one mentoring to high school and college students.

Volunteer eMentors deliver the curriculum utilizing a secure, monitored web-based system. All coordinators and volunteers are carefully screened and trained and are given specific tools and techniques to develop this unique relationship with students. eMentoring removes the time constraint and geographic availability issues that often limit volunteer recruitment.

SUMMER BRIDGE

ASPIRE summer bridge provides eMentoring to students who have recently graduated from high school and plan on attending an ASPIRE college: Lane Community College, University of Oregon, Tillamook Bay College, or Columbia Gorge Community College. During the summer, students receive 1:1 eMentoring, specific information on their college choice, and informational emails about registration, housing, orientation, and more!

COLLEGE PILOT

ASPIRE volunteer mentors provide specialized mentoring, advising, and resources to college students.





This program is for all students with a special focus toward students interested in health careers and who are from rural and underserved communities. The four participating colleges are: Lane Community College, Columbia Gorge Community College, Tillamook Bay Community College, and the University of Oregon's SAIL program.
