

# Barber & Hairdresser Grants

## WHO CAN APPLY?

Applicants must qualify under ALL of the following criteria:

- Resident of Oregon
- Attending a licensed school of barbering, hair design, cosmetology or manicure in Oregon
- Enrolled full-time
- Enrolled in a program which is at least nine (9) months long or 900 clock hours
- Have a significant need for financial help

## HOW CAN I APPLY?

You must complete the *Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)* need analysis form. Be sure to list the college code of the barber or beauty school you plan to attend.

You can get a *FAFSA* at the barber or beauty school, or from the Oregon Student Assistance Commission. Before you fill out the form, you should talk to the financial aid officer at the school you plan to attend.

## WHEN SHOULD I APPLY?

You can apply at any time. The Oregon Student Assistance Commission receives *FAFSA* information electronically from the U.S. Department of Education, so you do not have to send the commission a copy of your *FAFSA*.

Allow a total of four (4) weeks for your *FAFSA* to be processed and for your information to be sent to the Commission.

## HOW MUCH IS A B&H GRANT?

B&H Grants are a one-time award of \$600.

## WHO RECEIVES B&H GRANTS, AND HOW MANY ARE AWARDED EACH YEAR?

Because of limited funds, only students with a significant need for financial help receive B&H grants. The number of B&H grants varies.

Usually, about 90 students receive B&H grants each year. Recipients are randomly selected from all eligible B&H students.
