

UP TO 120 SCHOLARS SELECTED

- Graduating high school senior or recent high school graduate.
- Has never enrolled full time in a twoor four-year college program.
- Enroll full-time in the fall.
- Goal of earning a bachelor's degree.

Eligibility

- Resident of Oregon
- Financial Aid Application.
- No special recommendations.
- No GPA requirement.
- Need-based.
- Eligible undocumented students may apply.

Application checklist

- Start the Ford Family Scholarship application!
- Upload complete financial aid report -FAFSA or ORSAA - with SAI (no more than 8000).
- High School.
- Transcript through end of junior year.
- College plans must be in home state of OR.
- Activities.
- Personal statements 3: 150-word max ea.
- Family/household information.

Top three applicant issues

- 1. Applied to the wrong program.
- 2. Transcript.
- 3. Financial Aid Report.

Application tips

- Start the application on December 1: <u>www.tfff.org/scholarships</u>
- Read instructions.
- Required documents:
 Financial Aid report. Transcripts.
- Celebrate uniqueness.
- Proofread.
- Submit.
- Print or Save a copy of your application.








Oregon by the Numbers 2025 Edition

Hover over the interactive map to view rates for each Oregon county.





