Crosswords

Grade: 6, 7, 8

Time: 15-20 minutes

Background Information:

This activity uses a crossword puzzle to help students learn about a variety of careers in the healthcare, life and physical sciences, and art, media, and sports industries.

Helpful Vocabulary:

- Apprenticeship Programs
- Associate Degree
- · Bachelor's Degree

Material:

- Copies of the following handouts for each student:
 - Crossword puzzle
 - Crossword clues

Procedure:

Step 1: Explain that today you are going to learn about different career options available to you by completing a crossword puzzle.


Step 2:

- Hand out a copy of the blank crossword puzzle and the three clue sheets (health career, life and physical sciences, and art design, sports, and media).
- Instruct students to use the clues to complete the crossword.
 - Note if students are struggling to answer the questions here are some suggestions
 - Have students work in teams or groups
 - Encourage students to research
 - Every few minuets give students a few more letters/ words/ hints.
- All words used in the crossword are job titles.
- The first letter of each answer is provided.

Optional:

- The Facilitator Notes Page includes a list of answers with O*Net numbers in case students want to do additional research or need hints.
- The Facilitator Notes Page includes additional tips for modifying this activity to meet the needs
 of your students.





Crossword Puzzle Clue Sheet: Healthcare

Careers in the healthcare field: The answers to these crossword clues are all jobs related to the healthcare industry including jobs in hospitals, emergency medicine and, community health. Answers will be part or all of a job title. At least the first letter of the needed word is provided.

10. These healthcare workers clean, sterilize, and <i>prepare</i> laboratory and hospital equipment. They ensure that equipment is ready for <i>28 across</i> and doctors to use. You typically need a high school diploma for this career. Job Title: Medical Equipment P
11. 911 Operators often dispatch these healthcare workers to assess injuries, and provide basic emergency medical care (usually while <i>29 across</i> drives). You may need an associate degree for this career. Job Title: P
13. Open wide. These workers provide oral hygiene to patients, asses problems, and advise patients. You may need an associate degree for this career. Job Title: D Hygienist
19. Individuals who do this job take the notes and reports created by doctors, <i>28 across</i> , and other workers and <i>transcribe</i> or rewrite them in plain language and add them to patient records. You may need an associate degree for this job. Job Title: Medical Tr
28. Working alongside doctors and other healthcare providers, these workers assess patient health problems and provide care to ill patients. You may need a bachelor's degree for this career. Job Title: N
29. Turn on the sirens and let's go we don't have time to wait. These healthcare workers ensure that <i>11 across</i> arrive to the medical emergency quickly and safely. You typically need a high school diploma for this career. Job Title: A Driver
Down: 5. By implementing services and programs within a community these healthcare <i>workers</i> improve the overall <i>health</i> of an entire neighborhood You typically need a bachelor's degree for this career. Job Title: Community H (answer is two words with no space)
9. Being an MRI is like being a medical photographer. You use machines to take pictures of internal organs to help diagnose illnesses and injuries. You may need an associate degree for this career. Answer rhymes with impressionist. Job Title: MRI SP
15. Drop and give me 20 push-ups. These healthcare workers help manage and coordinate <i>fitness</i> and wellness programs. You may need a bachelor's degree for this career. Job Title: F Coordinator
21. Individuals who do this job schedule appointments, bill patients, and compile and maintain medical records. They also have a working knowledge of medical terminology. You may need a high school diploma for this job. Job Title: Medical S



Crossword Puzzle Clue Sheet: Life and Physical Sciences

Careers in life and physical sciences: The answers to these crossword clues are all jobs related to the agriculture, food production, or forestry/ natural resources management. Answers will be part or all of a job title. The first letter of the needed word is provided.

Across:
7. These workers support <i>14 down, 3 down,</i> and <i>23 across.</i> Ultimately these workers help ensure that woodlands are healthy and that the impacts of wildfire are reduced. You typically need a high school diploma for this career. Job Title: F Aid
17. Working alongside scientists, these technicians perform tests to determine if our food is safe to eat. You may need an associate degree for this career. Job Title: F Science Technician
23. If you like long walks in the woodlands then this job is for you. People who do this job help replant, maintain, and protect forests and other wild habitats. You may need an associate degree for this career. Job Title: F Worker
24. Technicians who do this job support agricultural scientists by preparing and running scientific tests, they may also help with animal care, or collecting samples from plants or animals. You may need an associate degree for this job. Job Title: A Technician
27. When farmers need help they may call these workers. These specialists analyze things like soil conditions, the amount of insects in an area, and how best to water <i>crops</i> to help farmers improve the amount of produce they can grow. You may need a bachelor's degree for this career. Job Title: C Specialist
Down: 3. People who do this job work with engineers and other professionals to collect data to build <i>maps</i> or to verify the accuracy of existing maps. You typically need an associate degree for this career. Job Title: M Technician
4. These people manage forests. They may help figure out how to protect wildlife habitat or determine when to cut down trees for economic benefit. You may need a bachelor's degree for this career. Job Title: F
8. These <i>green</i> workers plant and grow fruits and vegetables in protected dwellings. You may need a high school diploma for this career. Job Title: Gr Worker.
14. Scientists who work in this specialty are focused on how to <i>conserve</i> or protect the environment while at the same time making best use of our natural resources. You may need a bachelor's degree for this job. Job Title: C Scientist
26. These workers trap, catch, or gather wild animals or aquatic animals. They may use nets, traps, or other equipment. You may need a high school diploma for this job. Job Title: H




Crossword Puzzle Clue Sheet: Art Design, Sports, and Media

Careers in Art design, sports, and media: The answers to these crossword clues are all jobs in the arts or sports fields. Answers will be part or all of a job title. The first letter of the needed word is provided.

Across: 2. The individuals who do this job record the moving images you see in television, video, or film productions. You typically need an associate degree for this career. Job Title: C Operator
6. Smile for the camera. These artists take still pictures of landscapes, people, or merchandise. They use lighting and editing tools to enhance the quality of the image. You may need an associate degree for this career. Job Title: P
12. Individuals who do this job write the music you hear in movies, television, and on the radio. They may also conduct or direct musical groups like orchestras or choirs. You may need a bachelor's degree for this career. Job Title: C
20. Someone who does this job ensures that the <i>merchandise</i> you see in a store is displayed perfectly. They may also create displays for trade shows or conventions You may need an associate degree for this job. Job Title: M
22. Every sports team has one of these people on staff. They prepare a team for competition and assess the strengths and weaknesses of the <i>18 downs</i> . You may need a bachelor's degree for this career. Job Title: C
30. Taking a document or digital file and making exact copies is essentially what someone who does his job would do. You may need a high school diploma for this career. Answer rhymes with sprinter. Job Title: P
Down:
1. These workers author scripts, stories, and other material. You typically need a bachelor's degree for this career. Job Title: W
16. If you do this job you place plants and flowers into arrangements for celebrations or special events or occasions. You need a high school diploma for this career. Job Title: F
18. People who compete in sporting competitions. They are supported by a <i>22 across.</i> You may need at least a high school diploma for this career. Job Title: A
25. Individuals who do this job may assist <i>2 across</i> or <i>6 across</i> by setting up and controlling devices that help them see better. Some electrical experience would be helpful. You may need an associate degree for this job. Answer rhymes with sighting. Job Title: L Technicians





Facilitator Notes

Overview:

Career Crossword is a career exploration activity that highlights careers in healthcare, life and physical sciences, and art design, sports, and media. Students learn about different careers by answering clues and completing the crossword. This activity includes 30 clues (30 different careers). Clues are separated by job family and the average education needed to enter that job (bachelor's degree, associate degree, or high school diploma).

Each career description was written using information from O*Net. The complete list of careers and their O*Net is listed on the Career Matrix on the following page.

Extension Ideas:

This activity is designed to be a short self-contained activity that students can do as a group or independently. Facilitators can extend or modify the activity in several ways to meet the needs of their students, here are some suggestions.

- **Break it Down:** Because the clues are separated by job family you can break the crossword into smaller pieces by only giving students one set of clues at a time. This way you can spread out the activity over the course of several days.
 - If spacing out the activity over several days this provides the facilitator a chance to pre-teach some of the job titles.
- **Hide and Seek:** If using this activity in a classroom setting the facilitator can printout answers on paper and hide them around the room. When students get stuck the facilitator can encourage students to "take a walk" around the room and see if anything catches their eyes. Similarly facilitators can "hide" some of the answers in various lessons earlier in the day.
- **Beat the Clock:** In this modification students are given a time limit to solve a crossword clue, when time is up the answer is shared.
 - If using this activity the facilitator might opt to give verbal hints... for example our school has one of these and they work in the front office (Secretary).
- Group Work: If using this activity as a group activity you can divide students into various different groups to complete answers. You can divide students by job family or by education level. Encourage students to share answers between groups.
- **Backwards Crosswords:** In this strategy the facilitator gives students the answers but fails to tell them which questions they go to. This is strategy is helpful if you are short on time or students are struggling to complete the activity.
- **Discussion:** After students have completed the crossword puzzle facilitate a discussion. Ask students which careers sounded interesting and which didn't? What classes in high school or middle school could help them enter that career?
- Research: After completing the crossword have student select one career and complete an research project on that career.
