



Pearl Scholarship Fund

Scholarship Purpose: To award scholarships to students who have been or remain in foster care and wish to attend an Oregon public college or university and major in health sciences.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Requirement: Applicant must be or must have been in foster care
- Majoring in health sciences
- FAFSA or ORSAA required – based on financial need
- Age 26 or younger at time of first award
- Preference for students from Deschutes, Jefferson, and Crook counties, but open to all Oregon residents
- Must enroll at least half-time
- Automatically renewable for up to 5 years if renewal criteria met
